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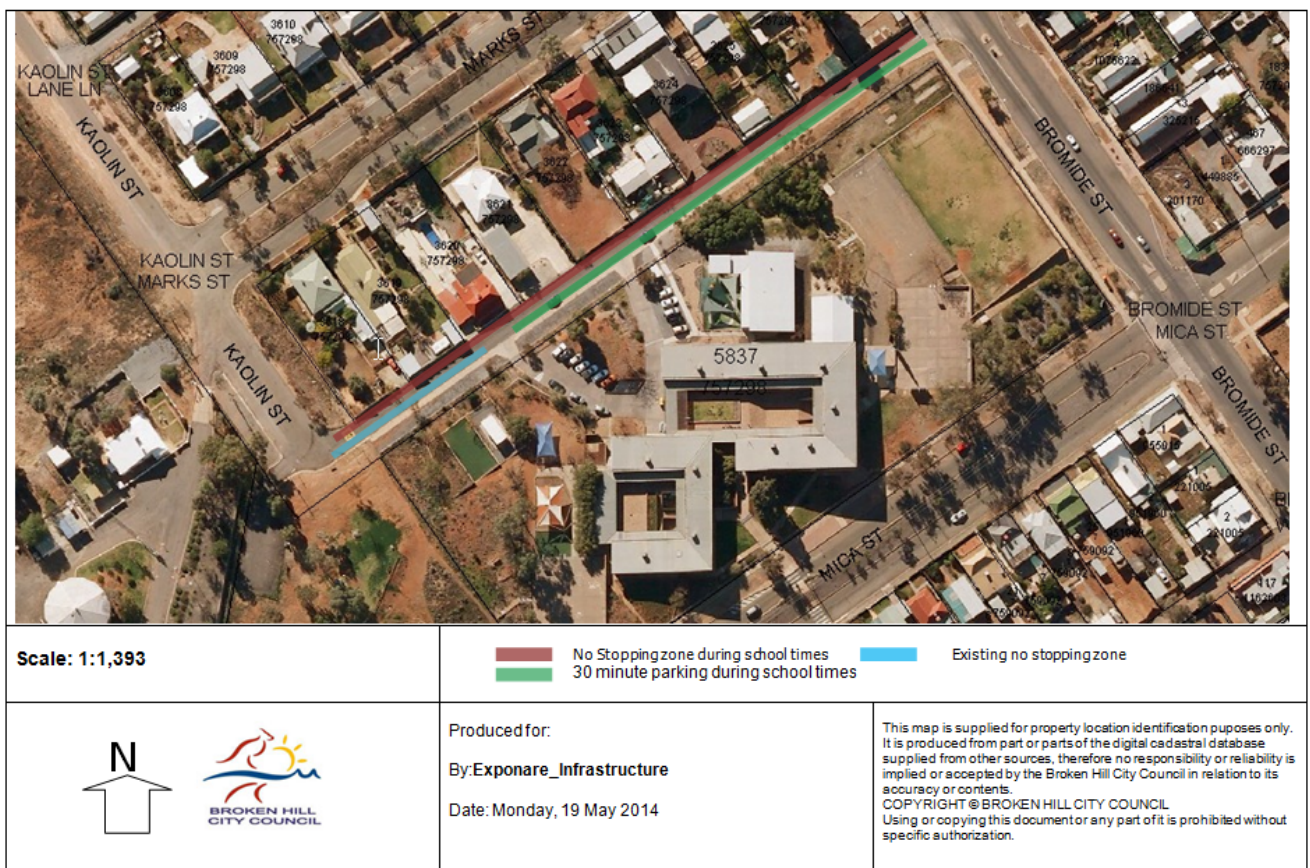

Please find details below in relation to Council's proposed changes to traffic arrangements in Mica Lane adjacent the Broken Hill Public School.

NOTIFICATION OF CHANGES TO TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS	
Proposed change	<p>Proposal to alter the parking arrangements and traffic conditions in Mica Lane were placed on display for public comment for a period of 28 days ending 05/08/2014.</p> <p>The Local Traffic Committee have considered the concerns raised from the public consultation and have agreed that the school side of Mica Lane be changed to a '30 Minute' parking zone and the other recommendations for the introduction of one-way traffic heading southwest (towards the lookout) and 'No Stopping' zone along the northwestern side be unchanged.</p>
Location?	Mica Lane between Bromide Street and Kaolin Street.
What are we considering?	<p>The LTC have reviewed the comments following the public consultation and as a result the following recommendations have been agreed.</p> <p>Traffic Committee Recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) That Mica Lane be altered to a one way street with traffic to flow Southwest (towards the lookout).(b) That a '30 Minute' parking zone be introduced in mica Lane along the school side of the lane. The restriction to apply from 8:00am to 9:00: am and 2:30pm to 3:30pm on school days.(c) That a 'No Stopping' zone be introduced in Mica Lane along the northwestern side of the lane (opposite the school). The restriction to apply from 8:00am to 9:00am and 2:30pm to 3:30pm on school days. <p>Council endorsed these recommendations at their meeting held 27th August 2014.</p>

<i>When we are doing?</i>	It is expected that new traffic arrangements for the one-way direction in Mica Lane will be in effect from 3 rd October and new signage to reflect parking changes will be enforced following the school holidays on Tuesday 7 th October, 2014.
<i>Is there anything that you should do?</i>	We would like to advise the local the general public to abide by these new traffic conditions.
