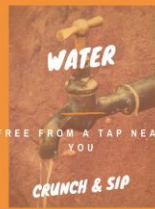
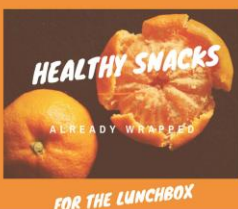
Ulysses Toy Run
