Morning Arrival to School

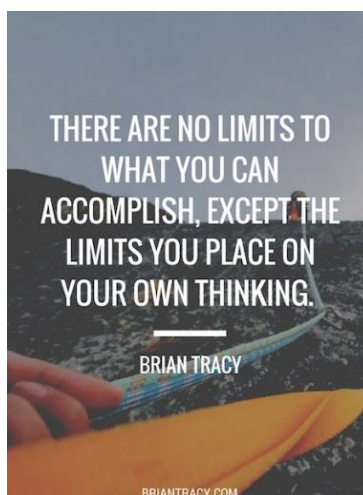

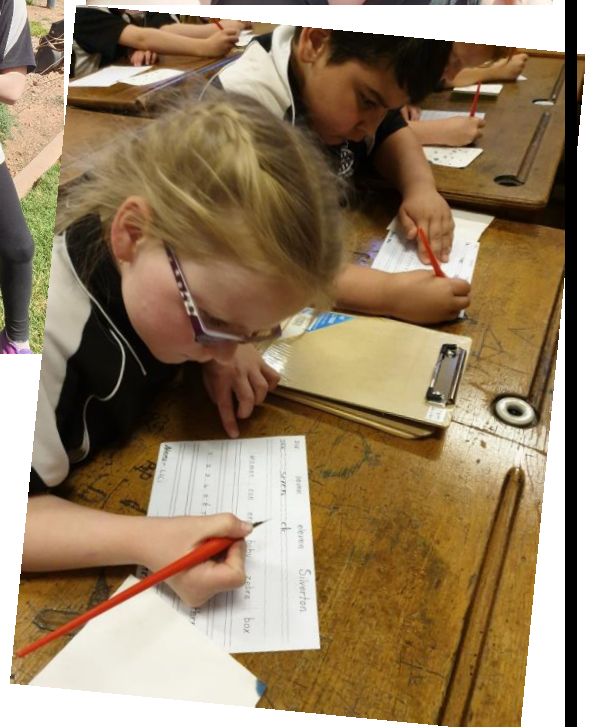
