Presentation Day:

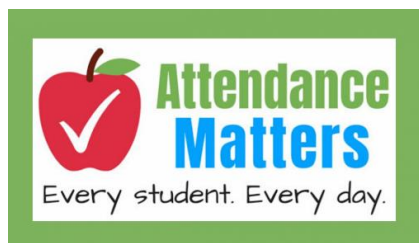
