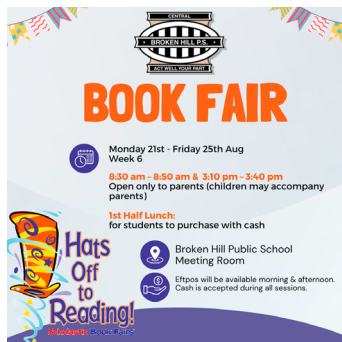
Mr T's Yarn
