Mathematics: Numbers

The children in Preschool have continued showing a great interest in counting and number recognition. We have been focusing on counting and numbers in Preschool during group times and play activities. During play and turn taking we use counting as a great strategy such as when children are waiting for their turn for the trampoline or when spinning in the blue dish. The children are counting to 10 or 20 and both forward and backwards. When your child is counting, we encourage you to emphasize the teen numbers by saying the numbers clearly and slowly to ensure they are saying all numbers. eg thirTEEN, fourTEEN.

The children are also engaging in number recognition with flash cards, posters, puzzles, tracing boards and more. Enjoying counting and recognising numbers in your environment with your child.
