### Important Medical Information

Please be aware that we have some children in Preschool with anaphylaxis and serve allergies to EGGS and NUTS as well as wheat and dairy. We are an EGG and NUT aware environment due to these children. All children wash their hands before and after meals too as they children are sensitive to touch too.

Please ensure you have clean hands on arrival to keep all children safe.

We appreciate donations of boxes and recycled materials to use in our program. Please avoid bring in egg cartons.

### Science Fun A Volcano
