#### **Focus Area**

In Preschool, we have been learning about 2D shapes. Maths is all around us and we engage in it everyday!

We have been focusing on shape names, number of sides and comparing shapes.

The main shapes so far have been:

- Triangle

- Rectangle
- Circle
- Our challenges have been pentagons and hexagons.

We have shapes all around us. We encourage you to find shapes around your house, car, community and have fun with your child as they gain confidence in naming, drawing and learning about shapes.

Ask your child: How do we know this is a rectangle and not a square? (A trick to remember for their age)

#### **Interest Area**

The children made our cubby into a pirate ship by adding flags and becoming pirates in the ship. This interest evolved as we set up our pirate area with treasure, books, ships, eye patches and other props. The children have engaged in treasure hunts, pirate games, role play and stories.
