A reminder to please bring back your child's signed goal sheet and the family feedback form. We are always looking for feedback on how we can improve this service and value your input.

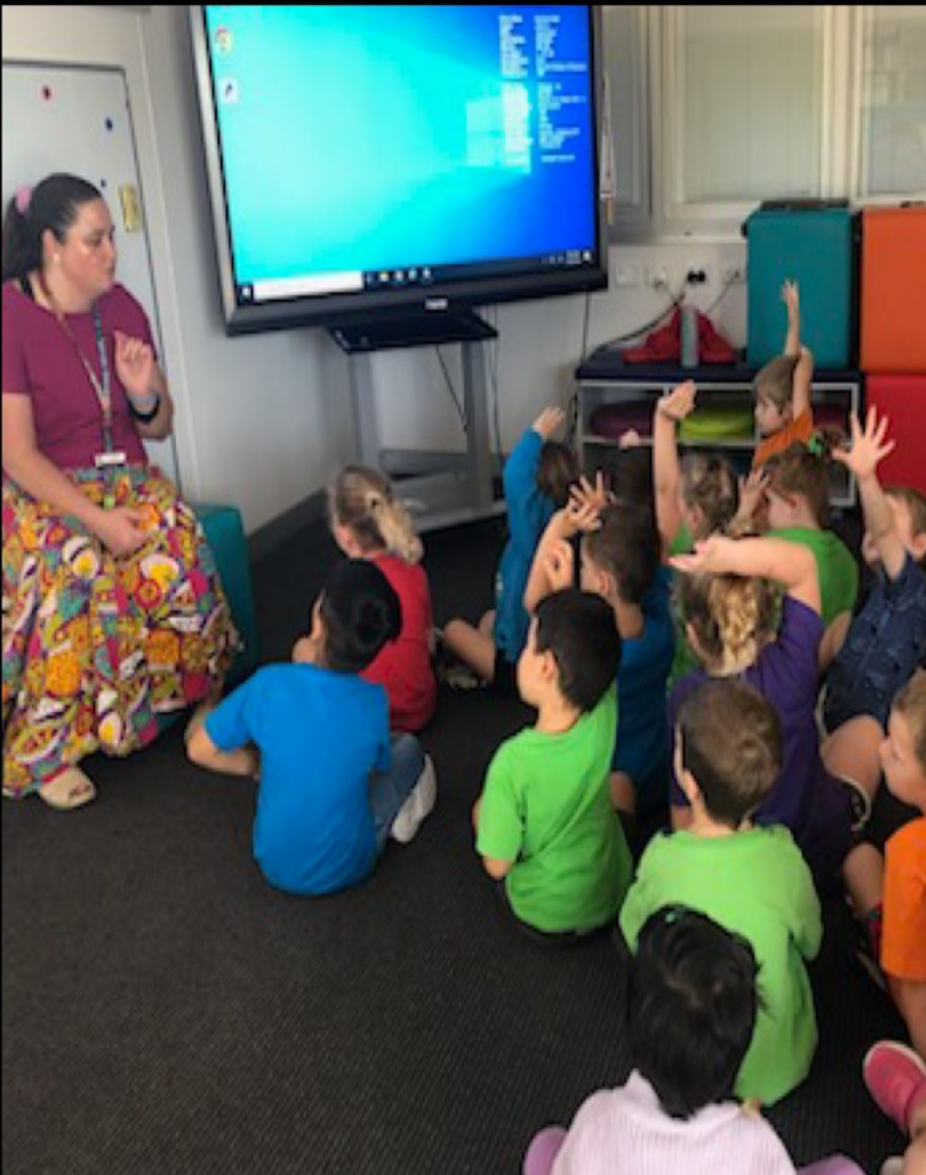
Children Unwell

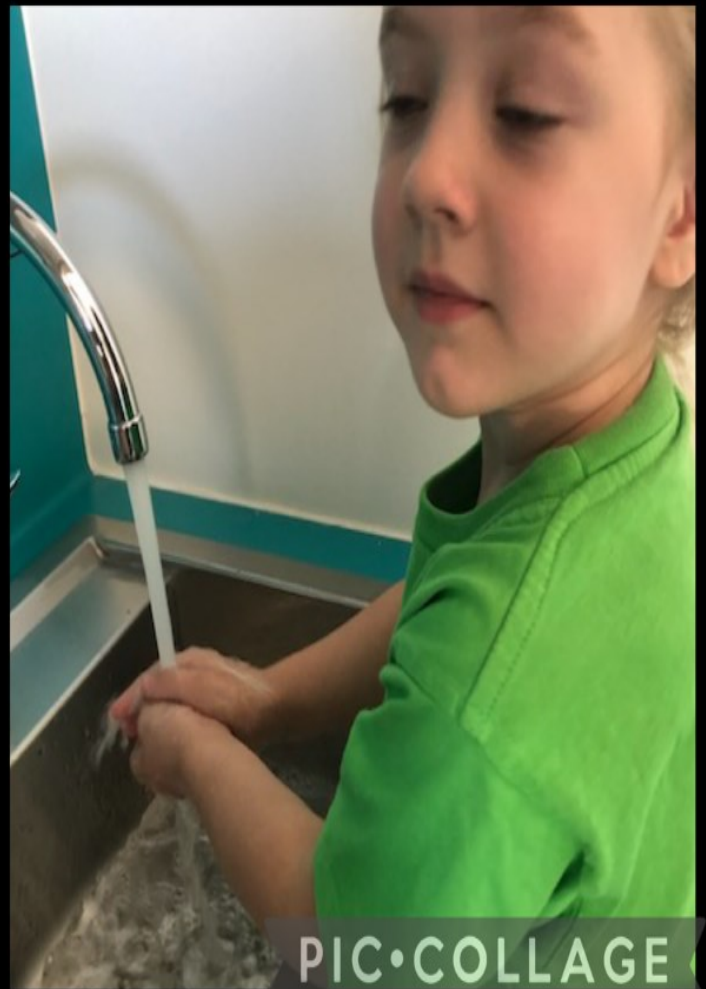
